FIELD DAY & JEANS DAY -- A reminder that this Friday April 29, 2016 is Field Day and a Jeans Day! Students in Kindergarten through 4th grade should wear their Field Day shirt with their P.E. shorts. Students in 5th-8th grade should wear their Field Day shirt with uniform pants/skort/jeans and change into P.E. shorts. Please make sure your child is wearing sunscreen! After the Field Day activities, many students may be wet and/or dirty so you may want to send along a towel, or have one in your car at pick up. For students that will go from Field Day to after care, please consider sending a change of clothes.

FIELD DAY DISMISSAL - Weather permitting, Field Day will be outside. If the weather does not cooperate we will set up in the Gym.

Plan for an organized dismissal at field day.

- 1) All students grades 2-8 bring their backpacks outside and place them on a designated spot on the parking lot to the right of field day activities. The spots will be marked for each grade.
- 2) When field day is over, each grade will line up in their fire drill lines.
- 3) Beginning with 2nd grade, each class will walk over one at a time to get their backpacks and get in a line on the grassy area outside the doorway of the building where we usually dismiss.
- 4) We will stand in the lines according to grades.
- 5) Older students who dismiss with **Pre-k, K, and 1st** in the Preschool hallway will walk in the door by the science lab to their dismissal area.
- 6) Gates will be opened when all are lined up.
- 7) The remainder of the students will be dismissed to their cars from the outside lines.
- 8) The bullhorn will be used if need to call the students to their cars.

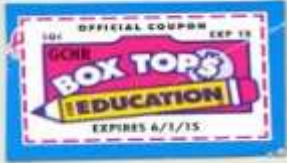
