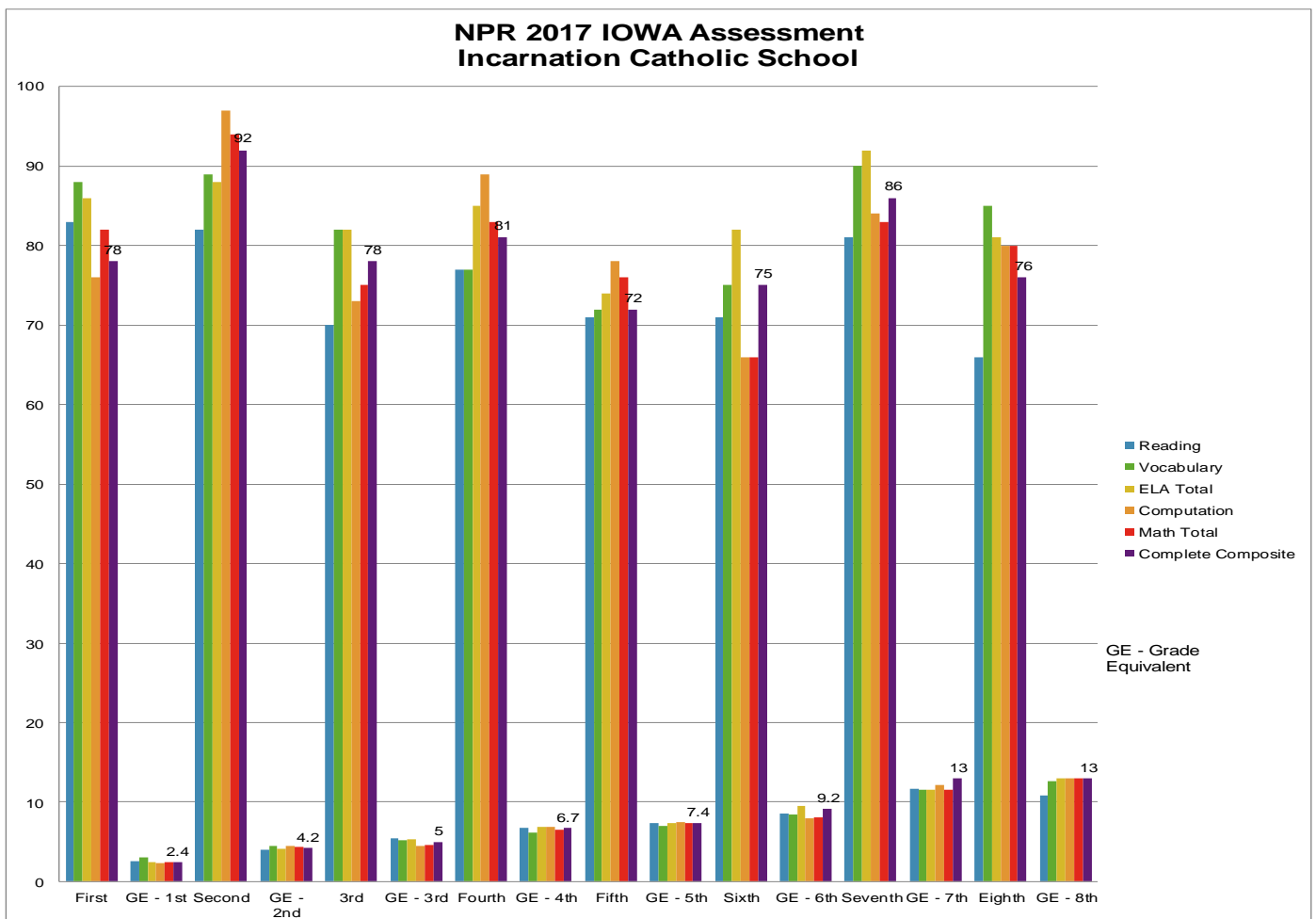
This and That—Elementary School
